Restigouche River Watershed Management Council (RRWMC)

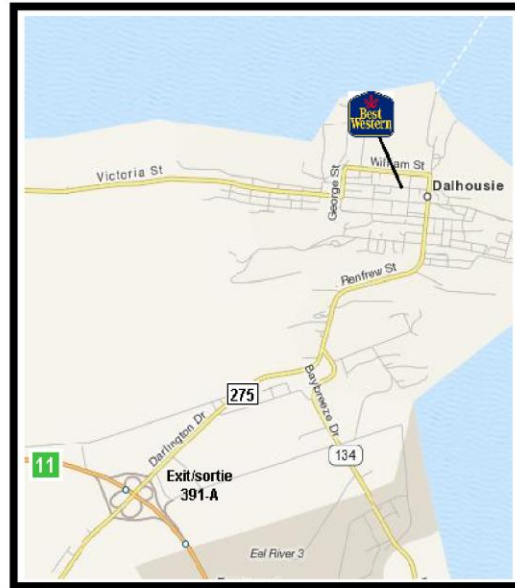
