Supervisor Kedgwick Area (1 position)

Job description

- 1. Supervise the Kedgwick Forks pool wardens :
 - Periodically, verify the site (the general maintenance has been performed by local wardens and the equipment are operational) :
 - Advise on daily activities for the site.
- 2. With his recreational and crown reserve sites crew, he makes sure that:
 - The fishing sites, the landings and the campsites are maintained adequately as per defined in the agreements with the government.
- 3. Furthermore, he will be ask to perform various tasks:
 - Act as a leader during the opening and closings of camps and campgrounds for all contracts;
 - Ensure maintenance is made for the organization equipment, ensure they are functioning well and are stored properly between seasons;
 - Inform the executive director of particular needs regarding materials or any problematic aspects affecting good management or conflicts perturbing adequate operation activities;
 - Communicate with wildlife assistants and the other supervisor for routine operation aspects;
 - Keep and give the invoices to the executive director monthly;
 - Fill out the daily activities journal and make a monthly report for the executive director;
 - Keep a record of the working hours of the employees under his supervision ;
 - Make sure the employees respect health and security standards;
 - Deliver and executre punctual projects occasionnaly;
 - Promote the protection of Atlantic Salmon and environment aspects in the Restigouche River Watershed
